Love of Books



- Ask for help when you need it



Possible Safeguarding Issue

At a recent Redruth Learning Group meeting they discussed an issue with a particular app that children have access to. It is called musical.ly and is apparently being used locally to groom children. The app basically works by filming yourself dancing and lip syncing to music - the security is not great and apparently children have been contacted and asked to remove clothing and film themselves. The app is very popular with children. It is supposed to be for older KS3 children but the lack of security means much younger children can access it. Please be aware of this app and I can confirm that HR at County and members of the Safeguarding Team have been informed.
